WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Individuals who have been ill or have been around those who have been ill in the past 3 days are asked to refrain from entering the library.

→ HOURS

Regular public service hours in DeRidder. Rural branches are slowly coming back online after repairs from storm damage. Call or check our website for branch opening updates.

→ SOCIAL DISTANCING

Individuals should maintain 6ft or more distance between others not from their own household whenever possible. **Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.**

→ COMPUTER USAGE

Computer usage is limited due to social distancing and is available on a first come, first served basis. WiFi is also available with a free library log-in account.

→ BUILDING CAPACITY

A **limited number of people** are allowed in the building at once, so please no loitering. This may mean waiting outside the library for someone to leave before you can come in. Your patience is greatly appreciated.

→ NO-CONTACT PICK UP

No-contact pick up is **available by request** for those who do not wish to come into the building.

→ FACE MASKS

Face masks covering mouth and nose are required in this building for everyone ages 8 and up. They are encouraged for everyone 2-7.

Those without a face mask are welcome to use our No-Contact Pick Up service.

→ MATERIALS QUARANTINE

Returned items are **quarantined 72 hours** before returning to circulation. This may cause delay in availabilities. Your patience is appreciated.
